

2025 Yuma Block Party Poker Run

The 2025 Poker Run (9 AM – 1 PM) will be conducted based upon four (4) free cards drawn from Ammo Can locations in the West Wetlands Park, and a fifth card purchased at the Poker Run Booth. Purchase price is set at \$5.

Prize Pool will be 90% of the total from the purchased fifth cards, distributed either 50%, 30%, 20% or, if the number of players exceeds 200, then 40%, 30%, 20%, 10%. In the event of a Push (identical tied hands), the places will be combined and then distributed equally. The total number of players will be limited by the number of decks in each Ammo Can (6 decks = 312 cards). Maximum Prize Pool would be \$1404. Because of the nature of the Prizes, the game will be restricted to adults only (21 and over). Cut-off time will be 1:00 (30 minutes prior to winner announcements.)

INSTRUCTIONS

1. There are four (4) Ammo Can caches located throughout the West Wetlands Park. Locations are listed below. Each Ammo Can contains sealed envelopes which each contain one (1) playing card. The envelopes are stamped to identify which Can they are from. **Do Not Open the Envelopes! Open envelopes will be disqualified!**
2. Visit each Ammo Can and take one (1), and only one, envelope from each can. **Do Not Open the Envelope!**
3. After visiting each Ammo Can, take the four (4) envelopes to the Poker Run booth. **Do Not Open the Envelopes!**
4. The poker Run staff will verify that the player has four (4) qualifying envelopes. The player will then pay for a fifth (5th) card.
5. The player selects a 5th card from a full deck. The 5th card will be recorded on a blank card. The Player prints their Geocaching ID on the card.
6. The Poker Run staff will then take and open the player's four (4) envelopes, reveal the cards, and record the complete hand on the blank card. Winning hands will be posted in the booth after the close. Winners will be announced during the winner announcements @ 1:30. Winners must be present to win.

For the benefit of those unfamiliar with Poker, the order of hands (highest to lowest) is as follows:

POKER HAND RANKINGS

ROYAL FLUSH		The best possible hand in Texas hold'em is the combination of ten, jack, queen, king, ace, all of the same suit
STRAIGHT FLUSH		Five cards of the same suit in sequential order
FOUR OF A KIND		Any four numerically matching cards
FULL HOUSE		Combination of three of a kind and a pair in the same hand
FLUSH		Five cards of the same suit, in any order
STRAIGHT		Five cards of any suit, in sequential order
THREE OF A KIND		Any three numerically matching cards
TWO PAIR		Two different pairs in the same hand
ONE PAIR		Any two numerically matching cards
HIGH CARD		The highest ranked card in your hand with an ace being the highest and two being the lowest
